




# ARGAUD TERRACE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Paul E. Argaud, being the owner of that certain 6.236 acre tract of land located in Section 34, Block 42, T-2-S, T. & P. Ry. Co. Survey and more particularly described in a deed from A. V. Shrubar et ux to Paul E. Argaud dated August 2, 1944 and recorded in Vol. 83, Page 398 of the Deed Records of Ector County, Texas have caused same to be subdivided into lots, blocks, streets and alleys as shown on the above plat and I hereby designate the subdivision as "ARGAUD TERRACE" and I do hereby dedicate the street and alleys, as shown, to the public for public use so long as they are used as such, but in the event all or any part or parts of said street or alleys shall cease to be used for public purposes the title shall revert to me, my heirs or assigns and I hereby retain unto myself, my heirs or assigns my interest in all the minerals in or under said street or alleys. This tract is not and has never been any part of my homestead.
