


REPLAT OF BLOCK ONE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Ozell Gillespie, a widow, being the owner of Block 1, Gillespie Addition to the City of Odessa, Texas, shown on the annexed plat, have caused same to be subdivided into Lots and Alleys, as shown on the annexed plat, and hereby dedicate the Alleys as shown to the public, for public use and benefit, so long as they are used as such, but in event any part or parts of said alleys shall cease to be used for public purposes, the title shall revert to me, my heirs or assigns. I do hereby reserve for myself, my heirs or assigns, all my mineral rights in or under said alleys. Grantor agrees that she will not drill for oil under said alleys unless same shall first be abandoned by Grantee.
