


# KELLEY AVE. ROAD DEDICATION



 owner of the property hereinafter dedicated to public use, do hereby dedicate to public use, forever,  
 as a public road, that portion of Kelley Avenue shown on the plat attached hereto, containing 1.49  
 acres, more or less, and being out of the 12.02 acre tract out of the Northwest part of Section 28,  
 Block 42, T-2-S, T&P Ry. Co. Survey, Ector County, Texas, conveyed by A. H. Dennison and wife,  
 Sadie E. Dennison, to Humble Oil & Refining Company by deed dated April 21, 1944, recorded in  
 Volume 81, page 245, Ector County, Texas, Deed Records, subject to the condition, however, that no  
 assessment or other lien for improvement of said street by way of installation of curb, gutter, paving,  
 or otherwise shall ever be levied against the property shown on the attached plat in the name of  
 Humble Oil & Refining Company nor shall the cost thereof ever be charged to or against or collected  
 from Humble Oil & Refining Company. The attached plat is made, subject to the condition herein  
 stated, for the purpose of description and dedication of the portion of Kelley Avenue shown thereon
