


RODESSA HEIGHTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, GEO. F. O'CONNOR and wife EUNICE V. O'CONNOR, being the owners of the tract of land shown on the above map have caused same to be subdivided into tracts, lots, blocks, streets, and alleys as shown on the above map, said subdivision to be known and designated as "RODESSA HEIGHTS" and we hereby dedicate the streets and alleys as shown on the above map to the public for public use so long as they are used as such but in the event the said streets and/or alleys or any part or parts thereof cease to be used for public purposes the title shall revert to us, our heirs and assigns and we further reserve unto ourselves all the minerals lying in and under said streets and alleys.
