


FOURTH REPLAT BLOCK II

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, Phillips Petroleum Company, a corporation, being the owner of Block II, Third Replat of Winton Addition and of two adjoining tracts, one containing 0.59 acres and the other being that portion of Whitaker Avenue abandoned by City Ordinance No. 198, containing 0.009 acres, both out of Section 28, Block 42, T-2-S, T & P Survey, all of which are described in a deed from D.B. Crowell et ux to Phillips Petroleum Company, recorded December 22, 1948 in Vol. 128 page 66, Deed Records, Ector County, Texas, has caused the same to be subdivided as shown on this plat and does hereby dedicate the same as "Fourth Replat Block II of Winton Addition and Adjoining Tracts out of Section 28, Block 42, T-2-S, T & P Survey." The said Company does hereby dedicate the streets and alleys, as shown, to the public and for public use so long as they are used as such, but in the event any part or parts of said streets or alleys shall cease to be used for public purpose, the title shall revert to Phillips Petroleum Company, its successors or assigns.
